

Privacy Policy – Meghan Josephine Music

1. Who am I?

This privacy policy applies to all services provided by Meghan Josephine Music, located in Linschoten and represented by independent artist Meghan Keereweer. I am responsible for processing personal data as outlined in this statement.

2. What personal data do I collect?

I process personal data from clients and interested parties. This includes:

- Full name
- Email address
- Telephone number
- Address details (for invoicing or event location)
- Information related to the performance or event
- Any media (photo/audio/video) from the performance

3. Why do I process this data?

I process your data for the following purposes:

- Handling bookings and communication
- Creating quotations and agreements
- Issuing invoices
- Fulfilling administrative and tax obligations
- Improving services
- Using photo/video content (only with consent) for promotional purposes

4. Retention period

Your data will not be stored longer than necessary:

- Booking records: up to 7 years (in accordance with Dutch tax laws)
- Contact forms and quotations: 2 years after the last contact
- Media: as long as consent remains valid or until a request for removal is received

5. Sharing with third parties

Your data will not be shared with third parties, unless:

- It is necessary to carry out the agreement (e.g. sound technician)
- Required by law (e.g. tax authorities)
- You have given explicit consent

6. Cookies & website

My website uses only functional and analytical cookies that do not infringe on your privacy. I do not use tracking cookies or personalized advertisements.

7. Your rights

You have the right to:

- View, modify, or delete your data
- Withdraw your consent
- Object to data processing
- Submit a complaint to the Dutch Data Protection Authority (Autoriteit Persoonsgegevens)
